Purpose: To provide parents and children an opportunity to enjoy camp activities together and grow as a family. We will offer archery, BBs, boating, swimming, sports, environmental education, tubing, canoeing, challenge course, fishing and group games. (horses and ceramics are part of our summer camp program but will not be offered at family camp)

We offer a separate program, Parent Child Weekend, for new camp parents who are seeking a dry run of the children's summer camp. That event is scheduled for April 25-27, 2008.

Schedule: On Thursday afternoon/evening, families will arrive and settle into cabins. We will have an orientation camp fire program to kick off the weekend.

Prior to the weekend, we will assign speedboat/tubing trips, canoe trips, archery, and challenge course times. These will be assigned to ensure that all families have the opportunity to participate equally. The other activities will be open during the weekend and families may choose how to spend their time.

Who may attend? Families! Children 3+ with an adult.

Accommodations? Families stay together as a family, regardless of the gender of the children. Families will share cabins with other families. We will partition our large cabins to create 2-3 cubicles within each large cabin. We have large, rustic, cabins with twin size bunks beds. The cabins are not air conditioned but are equipped with many large fans. All cabins are waterfront.

Restrooms are located adjacent to all cabins. They have hot and cold running water, showers and toilets with partitions. (no outhouses!)

Cost? The cost of the weekend is **\$125 per person.**

What to bring? You should pack the same things that you would bring for summer camp, only less of it!
-twin bed size sheets, blanket, pillow
-towels
-shampoo, shower gel, toothbrush, toothpaste, toiletries
-any prescription medications (must be kept by parents or turned into camp staff)
-clothes for cool and warm weather

- modest swimwear (no bikinis)
- pool shoes/ crocs (flip flops are not recommended)
- sneakers
- one plain white tee shirt for each member of your family (for a craft)
- clothes that can get very dirty (esp for parent-child competitions)
- sunscreen, bug repellent
- hat or visor
- don't bring things that are not permitted at camp. Don't bring electronic toys, fireworks, gameboys, chewing gum, cell phones, ipods, firearms, alcohol, drugs, etc.

Other Expectations:

Camp is a non-smoking, drug and alcohol free environment.

Families will take turns in assisting with some cleaning duties during family camp, sweeping, clearing tables, cabin clean up, etc.

Language, attire and behavior that is disruptive to the family camp experience will not be tolerated. Such behavior may result in expulsion from family camp without refund.

Shoes must be worn at all times (except inside cabins). Crocs are ideal since they can get wet but still provide protection for toes.

Cell phones/blackberries are not permitted during the weekend. We ask parents to keep electronic devices off and put away during the weekend. Please provide friends and family with the camp phone number (301-259-2645) for emergencies. We have found that cell phones and other electronics are disruptive and interfere with family togetherness.

Parents should participate in activities with

their children and provide supervision.
